- NOTE.** (1) In case the intimation is not received within one month of the commencement of training, the training shall run from the date of receipt of intimation in the Bar Council.
- (2) After passing LL.B., holder of LL.M. & Bar-at-Law having one year practical experience certificate are exempted from 6 Months training. Foreign degree-holders must have to pass a special equivalence examination for Law Graduate of Foreign Universities (SEE-LAW).
- (3) No person is eligible to submit Intimation Form if he/she is in any Govt./Semi-Govt./Private Service or Business.

1. The candidates must have passed LL.B. Examination (Final year) from a university recognized by the Pakistan Bar Council with minimum seventeen years education.
2. As per order of the Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan in C.P. Number 34 of 2012 (PLJ 2018 SC 815), candidates must have passed the **LAW-GAT** examination conducted by the **(HEC) Higher Education Commission of Pakistan** for enrollment as an advocate. Foreign degree-holders must also have to pass a special equivalence examinations for Law Graduate of Foreign Universities (SEE-LAW).
3. The candidates have maximum three chances to qualify the **HEC Law Graduate Assessment Test (LAW-GAT)**.
4. The candidates shall have to obtain 50 Marks to get through the written examination of **HEC Law Graduate Assessment Test (LAW-GAT)**.

6. The candidates are not eligible to undergo training/apprenticeship during service/employment or business.
7. After passing LL.B., holders of LL.M, Bar-at-Law Degree having one year practical experience certificate or possessing four years Legal/Judicial experience are eligible for direct Enrollment as an Advocate and may seek exemption from six month training. Foreign degree-holders must have to pass a special equivalence examination for Law Graduate of Foreign Universities (SEE-LAW).
